### best containers for the job

Trays are perfect for holding folded T-shirts, button-downs, and light sweaters. Stash items you don't use regularly in inexpensive bins and boxes. For long-term storage, containers should be lined with acid-free tissue paper to prevent fabrics from yellowing.

### smart tech touches

Designate an area for charging gadgets. I plug my iPhone and iPod into a combination surge protector and USB charger. To brighten the area, I use battery-operated lights. Design the back of a shelf with a mirror to reflect light into shadowy spots.
